## Summary of CV

This section describes briefly a summary of your career in science, academic and research; the main scientific and technological achievements and goals in your line of research in the medium -and long- term. It also includes other important aspects or peculiarities.

I am a historian whose work focuses on the study of the configuration of an Arab-Muslim society in al-Andalus during the Umayyad period (8th-11th c.). This complex process is reflected in the different types of existing sources of that time. The **multidisciplinary training** acquired thanks to my commitment to mobility has helped me develop skills to deal with all the sources for this place and period. To this end, I have attended leading academic institutions: B.A. in History from UPV/EHU and MSc in Archaeology from Autonomous University of Madrid, having also learnt Arabic at Complutense University of Madrid and Damascus University. Master's degree resulted in my being able to work with Digital Humanities tools (e.g. GIS). My master's thesis dealt with coin minting in al-Andalus in the 11th c. and was supervised by Dr. Alberto Canto. The thematic variety of my publications (Urban History, Cultural History, Numismatics and GIS) is a good example of the assimilation of the different disciplines.

I completed my training at CCHS-CSIC, where I carried out my PhD thesis under the supervision of Prof. Eduardo Manzano. I was also assisted by Prof. Jean-Pierre Van Staëvel at Sorbonne in developing the methodology of my research. The thesis analyses urban growth in south-eastern al-Andalus (cities were the first centres of Arabization and Islamization, besides being the centres of the Umayyad power) and its relationship with the articulation of a trans-Mediterranean trade. This socio-economic approach has received an excellent welcoming by the academic world. As a reflection of the above, I was awarded with the **Extraordinary Doctoral Award 2019** from the UPV/EHU.

The CCHS has a great **international projection**, offering me the possibility of collaborating with European projects (PIMIC, CORPI) and establishing close contacts with many foreign researchers. By developing my research as a "frontier" analysis between different eras and disciplines, I have also been able to strengthen networking. An example of this is my post-doctoral stay at Universität Hamburg under the supervision of Prof. Sabine Panzram. Thanks to her expertise in Urban History of Iberia in Late Antiquity, I could deepen my understanding of the Visigothic institutions and their role after the Arab conquest. That could only be achieved through mutual exchange of knowledge.

I currently hold a **post-doctoral position** at the UPV/EHU (Juan de la Cierva-Formación fellowship), where I am studying the mutual influence of the forms of appropriation of rural space in the Christian peninsular northwest and in the border strip of al-Andalus. I also share with Prof. Francesca Tinti the interest in the role of languages in the construction of identities. So much so that I was, together with her, the supervisor of a master's thesis on this subject.







# General quality indicators of scientific research

My research outputs have appeared in several high-impact journals/publishers, and are **highly cited in WOS and Scopus**, especially considering that they have been recently published. One of my articles was published in "Al-Qantara", which is the reference journal in the History of al-Andalus and the Maghreb, and another in "Arqueología y Territorio Medieval", which is a specialist journal on the Archaeology of the Iberian Peninsula in the Early Middle Ages. I also published another article in the American journal "eHumanista", which has acquired a growing popularity in Andalusian Studies in recent years, with contributions from the most prestigious researchers in the discipline.

I have also written **two monographs**. One of them provides an overview of the main findings of my PhD thesis, which has been published by the "Editorial de la Universidad de Jaén". This publisher has a long tradition in Andalusian historiography, including among its most representative volumes works by Prof. Pedro Chalmeta, Prof. Miquel Barceló or Dr. Manuel Acién. As for the second monograph, this was co-authored by Prof. Eduardo Manzano and myself, with the former being one of the leading international experts on the history of al-Andalus. I am also the editor of a collective book including 17 chapters written by leading researchers in Andalusian studies. It will be published in 2021. I am also the author of **two book chapters**: the first one was published by Ediciones UAM, a publisher ranked highly in the SPI ranking; while the second one will be published throughout 2020 by Archaeopress (co-authored with Dr. Chritopher Courault).

Furthermore, I have participated in conferences, workshops and seminars held at some highly renowned **academic institutions, including foreign** (University of Oxford, University of St Andrews, WarburgHaus, University of Göttingen, Saint Louis University, University of Hamburg, Denison University, Cervantes-Hamburg Institute) and Spanish ones (EEA-CSIC, Casa de Velázquez, ILC-CSIC, UAM, Casa Árabe, UCLM, University of Granada, IH-CSIC). This has been made possible thanks to the research grants I obtained from both international (Patty Foresman Fund, DAAD) and national institutions (Spanish Government, Basque Government, CSIC, UPV/EHU).

Since 2010, I have participated in **4 projects funded by the Spanish Ministry of Science**. As three of them were the most relevant projects on the History of al-Andalus during the Umayyad period, I have been able to work together with the leading international specialists in my field (e.g., Dr. Patrice Cressier, Prof. Carmen Barceló). I am also a member of the research network on the Iberian Peninsula of the Ancient and the Umayyad periods called "Toletum". Participants include such prominent researchers, such as Prof. Maribel Fierro, Prof. Sonia Gutiérrez and Dr. Alejandro García Sanjuan, among others.

Another aspect worthy of note is that I have organised various scientific events, such as the "II Encuentros con Clío" at the IH-CSIC and the first two editions of the "Jornadas de Introducción al Mundo Árabo-Musulmán" at the UPV/EHU (I am preparing the third edition). I have taught several subjects at the UPV/EHU (B.A. in History) and I obtained the accreditation by the ANECA as **Assistant Professor**.

The goal of this fellowship was to carry out of the research programme entitled "El triángulo Zaragoza - Tudela - Huesca en al-Andalus: dinámicas urbanas y su influencia en el mundo rural". 
