## B. SUMMARY OF THE CURRICULUM

I am full Professor of Archeology in the University of Alicante. My research focuses on the study of the material culture, the landscape and the social dynamics of the Iberian and Roman periods in Eastern Iberia. My studies on the Iberian Iron Age have made me one of the main specialists in the Spanish academia, with national and international reference publications. It is worth mentioning the monograph based on my doctoral thesis *The organization of the territory in the central area of the Iberian Contestania*. University of Alicante. Alicante (2002), or the participation in the *Oxford Handbook of the European Iron Age* (2018), with the chapter dedicated to "The Iberian Peninsula", wrote with Dr L. Armada.

Within the framework of my specialization in Landscape Archaeology, I participate in networks of international researchers such as the International *Seminario Internacional de Arqueología del Territorio Latinoamericana*, the *International Mediterranean Survey Workshops*, the Spanish-Portuguese network *ArkeoSIG* and the association Academic *The ArcLand International*. In this line, it is worth highlighting some publications of international projection such as the monograph Mayoral, V., Grau I. and Bellón J.P. (eds.) (2021):

I also focus my research interest on the applications of geospatial techniques in Archaeology, especially GIS. This topic has been one of my main lines of research since my doctoral stage, when these applications in Archaeology were being developed. For this purpose, I received training at the Department of Archaeology of the University of Southampton (UK) (February-June 1998) and at the Center for Advanced Spatial Technologies of the University of Arkansas (USA) (August-November 1999). I subsequently extended my research in this field as part of an MEC post-doctoral fellowship at the University of Southampton (September 2001-August 2003). My specialization in the application of GIS and other geospatial technologies has led me to specialized teaching in various institutions. I am professor in the postgraduate course in Geospatial Technologies at the IAM-INCIPIT of the CSIC (2015-today), in the doctorate in Spatial Archaeology at the University of Jaén (2013- today), in the Master's Degree in Archaeology at the universities of Córdoba, P. de Olavide-Sevilla, Cádiz, Huelva and Málaga, Spain (2006-2012), in the postgraduate GIS in Archaeology of the CSIC (2006-2010), in the Master of Archaeology of the University of Jaén, Spain (2007-2011) or in the Master of Classical Archaeology of the Institut Català d'Arqueologia Clàssica (2007). I also have been teacher in the postgraduate course of Archaeology at the University of Tucumán (Argentina) (2021).

My fieldwork is developed mainly in the northern regions of Alicante, where I directed and co-directed excavations of El Cabeço de Mariola, El Puig d'Alcoi, La Serreta and other archaeological sites. I also carried out archaeological research in Giano dell'Umbria (Perugia, Italy) 2007-2013 and in Tarifa (Cádiz) 2014-2015, as a researcher for the Franco-German project *Archeostraits* ANS-DFG. Also I have developed my research in the Central Pacific (Polynesian islands of Wallis and Futuna,), as a researcher in the *Archaeology of the First European contact in the Pacific* 2018-2020 project of the DFG and in the *ComplexEquals project Social complexity and egalitarianism: Analysis of the landscape of the first village communities of the La Ciénega valley (Province of Tucumán, Argentina)* founded by the CSIC (2021-present).

I was visiting researcher at the University of Southampton (September 2001 to August 2003), Northern Arizona University (USA) (April-May 2008), Brown University (USA) (April 2016), Leiden Universiteit (Netherlands) (December 2017-February 2018) and Université de Bordeaux-Montaigne (France)(September 2021).
